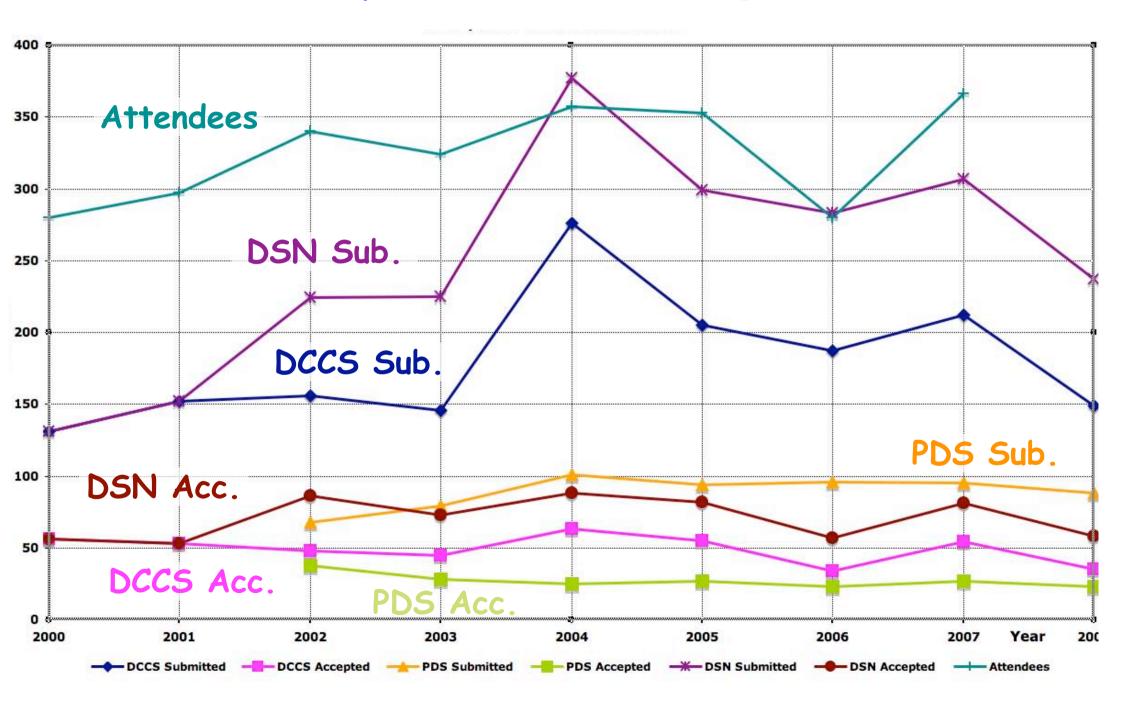

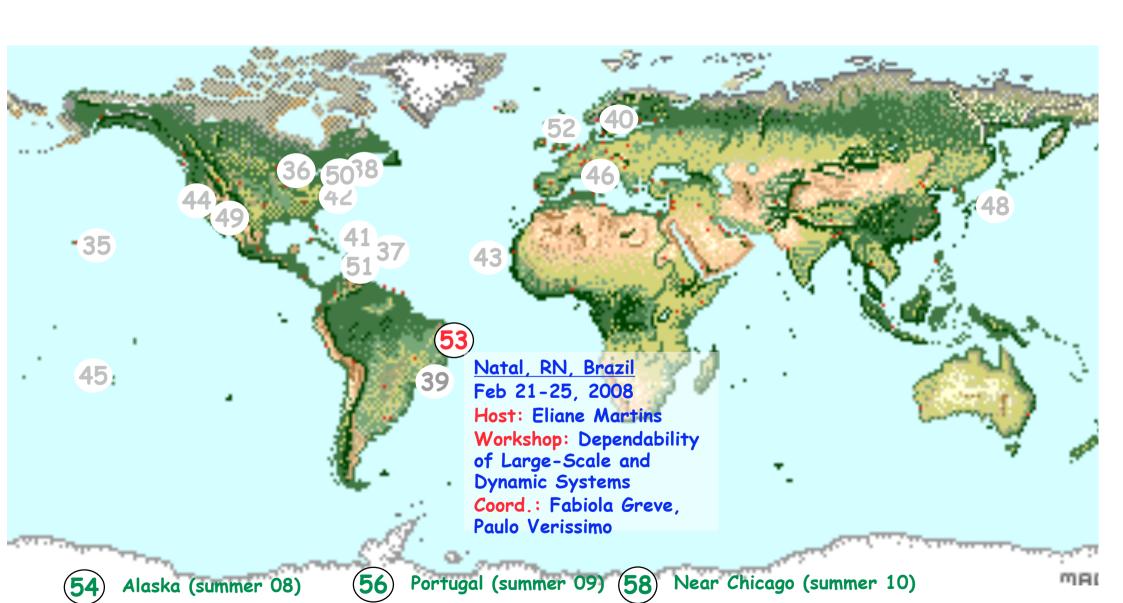

■ Rationale

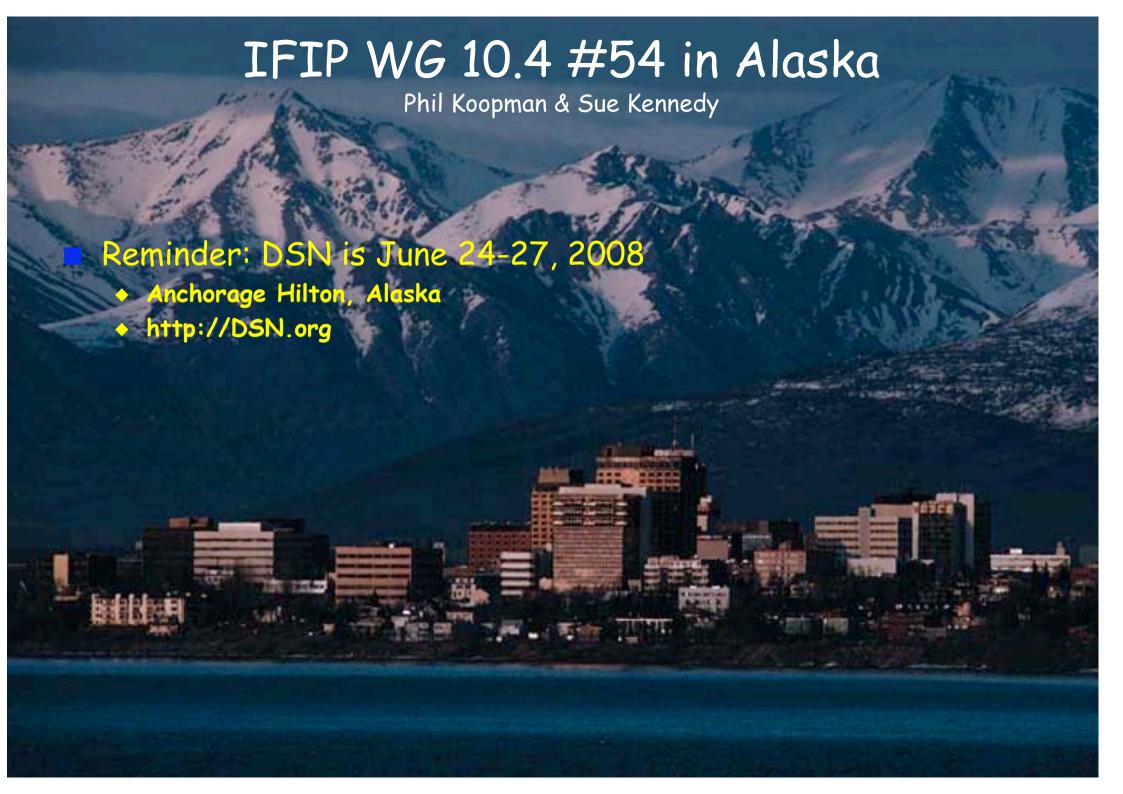
- ◆ Hardware-related issues are becoming (again!) an increasing concern wrt to Dependable and Secure Computing: production yield ≥, sensitivity to soft errors ¬, new architectural paradigms, side channel attacks, testing features vs. security vulnerabilities, emerging nanotechnologies, etc.
- ◆ Decreased attention paid on HW issues within FTCS/DSN, at the turn of the century and main players/actors are no longer within DSN!
- Workshop on Dependable and Secure Nanocomputing at DSN'07 organized together with Ravi Iyer and Michael Nicolaïdis
- ♦ Well-attended and the feedback received was very much encouraging!
- ◆ It appears essential to explicitly recognize such an important trend and provide a related forum within DSN

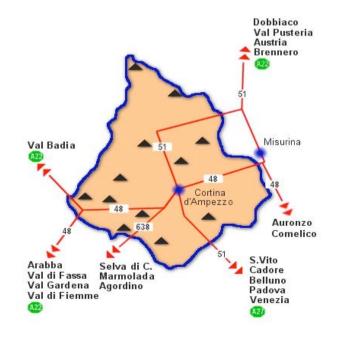




How to reach Cortina D'ampezzo

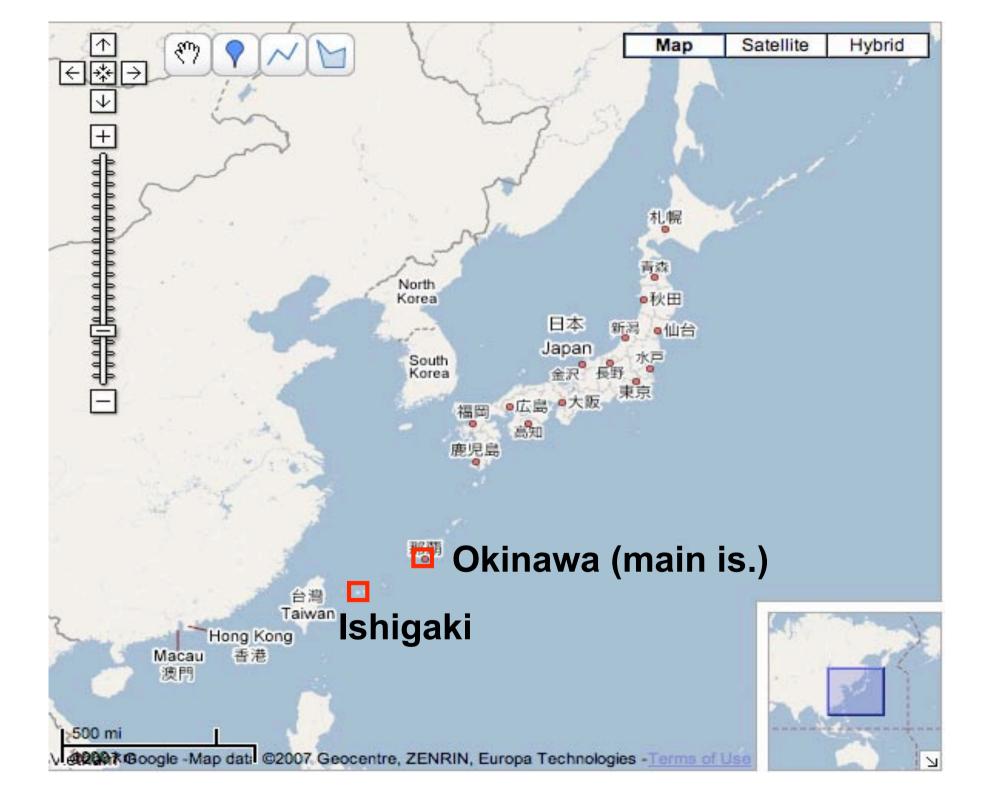
